Melhop Trust Scholarship Applications

Club Garibaldi, which administers the Melhop Trust, invites applications for funding from eligible students. Applicants should be no older than 30 years at the time of application and be engaged, or about to engage, in a formal course of study provided by a recognised educational establishment in one or more of the following fields, namely, Language and Literature, including the publication of Italian migrant histories, Vocal and Instrumental Music, the Graphic Arts or Architecture and Engineering. Applications close on 30 April 2021. Applications, citing the course of academic study or project and demonstrating the applicant's Italian heritage, are to be sent in writing to the Secretary, Club Garibaldi, 118 Tory Street, Te Aro, Wellington 6451, or to clubgaribaldi1882@gmail.com. Ondazzurra is the only radio-podcasts programme in Italian language produced in New Zealand. Broadcasting started in September 2016 with the intent to aggregate and giving voice to Italian living here.

Over the past four and half years *Ondazzurra* has grown from zero to achieve significant goals in term of audience and credibility.

Every week *Ondazzurra* produces a half-hour programme which airs on Sunday morning at 11.20 on Planet FM 104.6

The typical format is a conversation with an Italian guest who talks about their experience in New Zealand, their reasons for coming here and integration into cultural, social and professional life.

The sum of those recorded conversation creates a vibrant and dynamic archive of the current Italian presence in New Zealand.

Each episode is transferred to podcast for easy online access, nationally and internationally, and is listed with a short introduction text.

Ondazzurra is constantly increasing its audience and has achieved more that 26,000 downloads, confirming the value of the programma to the Italian and italophone community.
