The countdown has begun for the annual Football game between Club Italia, nelson, and Garibaldi.



Circolo Italiano di Wellington — Meet Italy!

Thursday 14 September 2023 at 7.30pm Italian Space Exploration

Stuart Mossman, Astronomy student Swinburne University Melbourne

Stuart's presentation will include discussion of:

Geostationary orbiting satellites communicating with satellite terminals installed at Venice's lagoon inlet stations to notify changes in wave height, aiming to improve floodgate control.



An Italian Space Agency camera, the LICIACube, formed part of the NASA test for planetary defence. The camera recorded the impact of a spacecraft on the asteroid Dimorphos as it approached the earth's orbit in 2022. Designed to alter the asteroid's orbit, this provided a theoretical mechanism to address potential asteroids colliding with Earth.
