# Club Premises (2023)

Club Building Sub-committee members have viewed two more properties with real estate agents, and made enquires on another property, in the last few months.

These properties did not meet the requirements of the Club. Therefore, it has been decided to renew the current lease of the Tory Street premises for another year, 2023, on similar terms and conditions as in the present lease, with some amendments Circolo Italiano has indicated that they will continue to hire our clubrooms for 2023 on similar terms and conditions as the present Agreement.

The interest and income from the investment of the Club's funds, and Circolo's rent, sufficiently covers the Club's rent and operating expenses.

The Sub-committee intend to keep looking for a suitable building or floor in an existing building for future Club premises.
