A HEART-WARMING ITEM OF INTEREST

The Telegraph, Australia - Thursday, 12 January 2013 Dog turns up to dead owner's church every day



Two months after his owner died, a dog in Italy keeps turning up each day at the church she used to attend.

Ciccio, a 12-year-old German shepherd, waits in vain in front of the altar of the Church of Santa Maria Assunta in the village of San Donaci, in the southern region of Puglia. He heads to the church as soon as the bells begin to ring each afternoon, just as he did for years when his owner was alive. The woman, who was known in local dialect as "Maria tu lu campu" - "Maria of the fields" – died suddenly in November. Ciccio attended the funeral, following his mistress's coffin as it was carried into the

church. The dog's devotion has so impressed villagers that they have adopted him as their own, giving him food and water and letting him sleep in a covered area outside the church. The local priest, Donato Panna, allows him to sit in front of the altar during Masses, baptisms and other services. He is now hoping to find a new home for the faithful hound.

If you wish to enrol Online please visit the website and submit a completed enrolment form. An acknowledgement will be forwarded to you by email and this will contain confirmation that your enrolment has been accepted. Further instructions and information will also be supplied.

If there is a place in your preferred class you can then post your application and cheque to Circolo Italiano di Wellington, PO Box 9706, Marion Square Wellington 6141. We also offer Internet banking: Westpac Wellington Branch, account number 03.0502.0855498.00. Please ensure you enter your surname in the reference box. To ensure a place in your preferred class it is advisable that enrolments be made by post or through the Internet prior to Wednesday 23 January 2013. <u>We cannot guarantee you a place if you leave enrolment until the General evening on Wednesday 30 January (between 5.30 and 7pm)</u>.

It is not necessary for Club Garibaldi members to join the Circolo and only the course fees need to be paid -\$195 for 30 fifty-five minute lessons. The textbook required is: **Buongiorno Italia (2005 edition)** for Beginners Stage 1 and 2. It is essential that each student has a copy of the relevant textbook. Cost: \$64.99 less 10% discount= \$58.50. To receive the 10% discount at the checkout counter, you will need to show evidence that you are enrolled into a Circolo course.
