On Wednesday 24 August 2016, the town of Amatrice in Italy changed forever after a 6.2 magnitude earthquake destroyed the township and many towns around it. Hundreds of people have died and many are missing. Such a tragedy.

Our sympathies go out to all those families and those who have family and friends in the town. RIP

On Friday 9 September, the Victoria University Italian Society held a fundraiser to help those affected in Italy. All proceeds from this will go to

the Red Cross, Italy. Jay Evett their President, approached the Club to ask if we could help. We gave them the use of the Club Free-of-Charge. A thank you note from Jay follows
