## Note from the President

As the end of the year draws near I look back and wow what a strange year it's been.

Unfortunately we had to cancel many of our planned social events this year due to Covid-19 but looking ahead we plan to reschedule most of these in 2021.

The cost of maintaining our ageing building, and the diminishing income to service rates, insurance and the impact of COVID-19, will eventually exhaust our financial reserves. The Club membership was informed of the reasons why a sale of the Club's property and relocation to other premises was considered to be in the best interests of the Club with a view to securing its continuation and long term future.

The AGM held on 8 November last gained the required 75% majority of those present at the meeting to proceed along these lines.

A marketing plan is presently being prepared to sell the Club's property next year by closed tender at no less than the market valuation prepared by an independent registered valuer, obtained for this purpose.



An experienced group, delegated by the meeting to negotiate the sale and relocation process, are as follows: Rex Da Vanzo (Lawyer), Dean Soldera (Accountant), Vic Criscillo (Trustee and chair of the Building Committee), David Monastra (Quantity Surveyor) and the legal firm of Gault Mitchell. Two of this group negotiated the sale of our Wakefield Street premises in 1990 and the later acquisition of our present premises and have been actively involved in the Club's management since.

I have total trust that the above group will achieve the best possible outcome for the Club.








#### Condolences


