#### AN ARTICLE OF INTEREST

Researchers from the United States claim to have cracked the riddle of why Italian-made Stradivari violins have a distinctive sound. Joseph Nagyvary, a biochemist at Texas A&M University, believes that wood-preserving chemicals are responsible for the 18th-century instruments` unique sound - explaining why following generations of violin-makers have never been able to recreate the famous violins from natural wood. The violin-makers would have used the potion to protect the wood from being eaten by worms, but it had another effect, according to Nagyvary. `It influenced the mechanical and acoustic properties of the wood, giving the instruments a sound without equal,`` he said.

Nagyvary`s team has succeeded in identifying the special chemical cocktail used on the instruments to be borax, fluorides, chromium and iron salts which forms the base of the wood-preserving mixture. Nagyvary has been working on his theory for over 30 years since learning to play the violin on an instrument once belonging to Albert Einstein. Around 600 of the 1,000 violins

thought to have been made by Antonio Stradivari still exist, each valued at around five million dollars.
