Club Garibaldi Property

The pending sale of the club's property puts us in a stronger financial position for the long-term and opens up a number of opportunities and options for the future.

At the Annual General Meeting on Sunday 8th November 2020 two motions were passed to sell the club's property for more than the current market valuation and to purchase or lease other premises.

Our property has been sold to an apartment building developer with settlement on 30th June 2021, for \$4.23m, which is significantly more than the market valuation of \$3.52m provided by the independent registered valuer, Telfer Young.

The terms and conditions of the Sale Agreement negotiated by the club's representatives include the leaseback of the second floor (clubrooms) for 12 months from the settlement date, rent free, with a right of renewal for an additional 6 months, on stated terms, if required. This gives the club up to 18 months to purchase a more suitable building, or a floor in an existing building. If no suitable premises are purchased in this timeframe, we will continue to invest the substantial funds, and lease premises for a minimum period. The car parks will continue to be available for club members to use for this period.

The building sub-committee have drafted the criteria for the requirements of suitable future premises for the club. The potential for a better future for the club is reassuring.

The executive committee thanks the club's representatives: Vic Criscillo, Rex Da Vanzo, David Monastra and Dean Soldera for the successful negotiations and sale.
