## **Aldo Cucurullo Memorial Trophy: Football Game 2021**

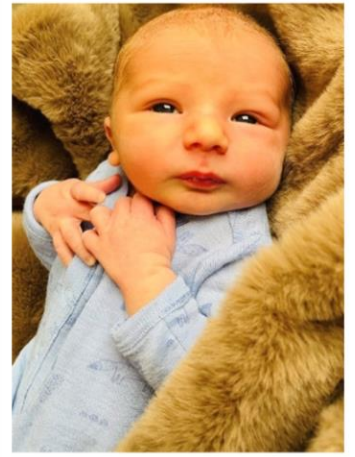

Liberato Cacace became a professional footballer at 17 years of age with his debut with the Phoenix in the A League. He spent two and a half seasons with the Phoenix.

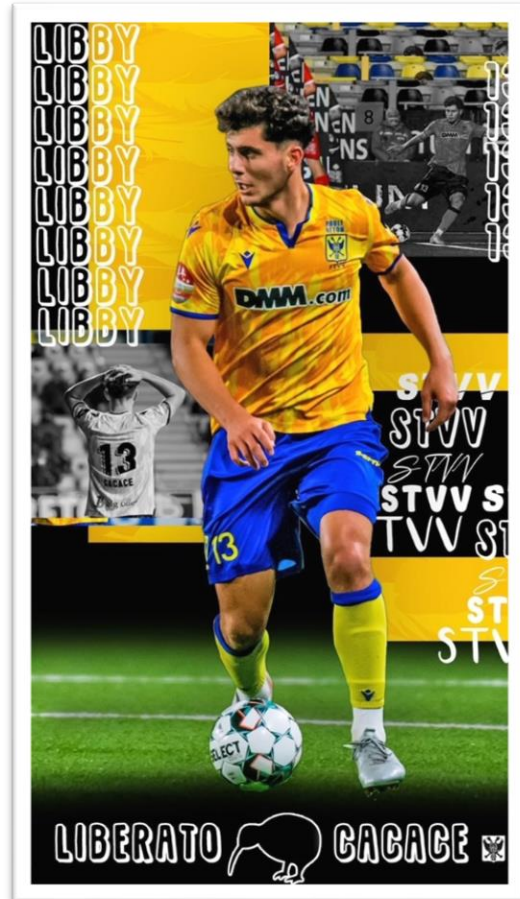
Liberato twice won the award for the best under 23 player and also won the prestigious Harry Kewell medal voted by all the players in the A League the best under 23 player.

In August 2020 he was transferred to STVV Belgium Premier League. In his first season in Europe he played 26 out of 32 games.

Liberato is already an All White and was selected in the Oly Whites for the Tokyo 2020 Olympics where this team made history for NZ football winning the first game and going through to the quarter finals.

During this wonderful Olympic experience his fantastic goal against Honduras was the talking point. Now he is back in Belgium for his second season in Europe.

It' so good to hear that Lib is enjoying and doing well with his Football in Belgium. We wish him all the best in his 2nd season in Europe.
