Riposa in Pace Salvatore (Salve) Famularo

On the morning of Friday 16 June 2023, Salvatore Famularo passed away at Lansdowne Park Rest Home in Masterton, just three weeks away from his 100th birthday. Salve's wife of 70 years, Laura Famularo passed away on December 3rd, 2020.

Despite Laura being warned that Neopolitans and Strombolani's should never marry, the couple wed at St Peter & St Paul Church, Lower Hutt on 4 February 1950. Laura's parents Antonio and Maria came from Sorrento and Massa Lubrense respectively and were market gardeners in Lower Hutt. Salvatore's parents Gaetano and Annunziata Famularo came from Stromboli and were an Island Bay fishing family.

Both Salve and Laura regularly attended the Garibaldi Club with their family. The couple first moved to Linden where they built a house. Salve used to take his fish cart to the Wairarapa where he noticed the warmer weather was better for his health, and the couple moved with their growing family to Masterton in 1959, eventually having seven children - Michael, Maria, Anita, Angela, David, Peter and Paul.

Salve and Laura built their own dairy in High Street which was very successful, and then a fish & chip shop which was even more popular and which Salvatore continued to run well into his retirement, while Laura ran her own successful tour business called Laura's Wairarapa Tours.

The couple became much more involved with their Italian heritage in retirement, Laura visiting Italy twice while Salvatore never had any desire to travel further than Australia. Laura also took the time to research and record the histories of both sides of the families, which are now an invaluable record of the family ancestors.

Salve was born on Stromboli when his parents returned to Italy where his father served in the Marines, coming to New Zealand with them when he was 20 months old. He only became officially a naturalised New Zealander when 63, but said he always thought of himself as a New Zealander.

Right until his death, Salvatore enjoyed getting a printed copy of the Club Garibaldi News. Laura and Salve are now buried together at Riverside Cemetery in Masterton.
