### *"Four Seasons In One Game"*

The 2021 edition of the Aldo Cuccurullo Memorial Trophy football game was played out in some very changeable weather conditions on Saturday 13 November.

The game started off in swirling wind and rain, with Club Italia deciding to play against the strong wind in the first half.

Club Italia dominated the opening period of the game in spite of playing into the wind, and their quick forwards launched several raids on the Club Garibaldi goal, but Club Garibaldi scrambled well, and managed to repel the attacks.

Against the run of play, Club Garibaldi appeared to have taken the lead, when central defender Kerryn Friday beautifully headed the ball into the Club Italia net off a perfect cross from Darren Cheriton. Unfortunately, the goal was ruled out due to Kerryn being adjudged offside, but this near thing put Club Italia on notice, and infused Club Garibaldi with confidence to attack.

The confidence paid off, when Nick Volpicelli Muollo, in only his second appearance for Club Garibaldi, scored a fantastic headed goal to give Garibaldi the lead. Club Italia were shocked into action, and redoubled their efforts to get back on level terms, but Club

Garibaldi held strong, and added to the lead before half-time, when Gian Pasquale Moreno coolly converted a penalty kick after a foul in the box.

Going into the break 2-0 up, Club Garibaldi had the upper hand, particularly as the wind appeared to be dropping in strength.

In the second half, the rain dried up, the wind softened, the sun appeared and the temperature increased – four seasons in one game. Club Italia had to attack, and took the ball forward at every opportunity, but Club Garibaldi were able to repel the attacks, thanks to an all-hands-on-deck approach to defence, and some excellent keeping from Club Garibaldi keeper, Antonino De Gregorio – who courageously played the game with a fractured foot.

Club Garibaldi continued to repel Club Italia attacks, and with 5 minutes to go, put the game beyond reach, when Nick Volpicelli Muollo beautifully curved the ball into the far corner of the Club Italia net.

The final whistle sounded soon after with a score-line of 3-0 to Club Garibaldi, which reflected Club Garibaldi's clinical conversion of chances, rather than a complete domination of the game. Players of the match were Nick Volpicelli Muollo for Club Garibaldi with his wonderful goals, and Michael Musso for Club Italia, who showed his steel and heart at the back for Club Italia.

The post-match function at Club Garibaldi was enjoyed by all, with a delightful three course meal prepared by Alphonse Basile. Huge thanks to Linda De Gregorio, and to all the Club Garibaldi members who put this event together in such challenging times. We look forward to defending the Cup in Nelson next year.

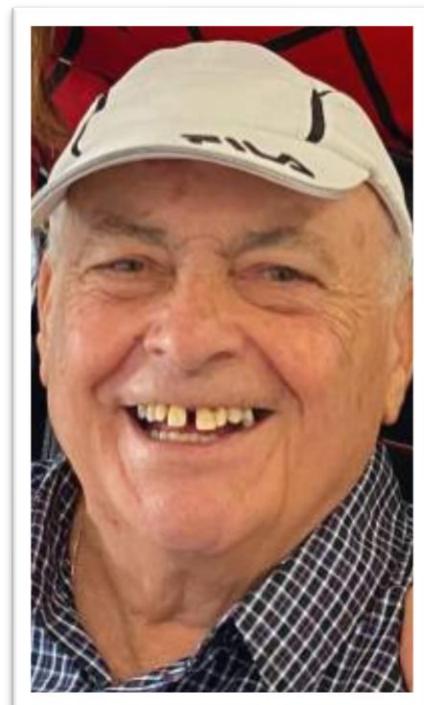
Ruffy and Josephine along with their family, have been long-time members of this Club.
