


Profits from the raffles will go towards helping our Boys get to Nelson for the 25th Anniversary football game between both Clubs

#### **Melhop Trust Award**

Club Garibaldi, which administers the Melhop Trust, invites applications for funding from eligible students. The ceremony has been adopted in Island Bay by its Italian community since 1933, when the fishing boat Santina foundered in Cook Strait, with the loss of four crew including three Italians.

The "Blessing of the Boats" attracts large crowds to the coastline, who come to watch boats from all over Wellington be put through their paces and blessed for safe carriage and bountiful catches.

Unique to Island Bay, local and visiting Clergy venture out into the Bay to bless the fishing boats after they've made a trip around Tapu te Ranga Island.
